LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear collaborators and friends,

It is an honour to address all of you in this letter as president of the Spanish Federation of Food Banks in this year of 2022. I want firstly to express my sincere thanks to each of you for your dedication and effort in supporting our mission to fight hunger and poverty in Spain.

We started 2022 with the satisfaction of having practically overcome the COVID-19 pandemic. But on February 24, the Russian invasion of Ukraine took place. Just as the world economy was recovering from the consequences of the pandemic, the worst global energy crisis since 1970 and slowing growth contributed to a rise in inflation; particularly affecting the price of food.

This is the dramatic scenario in which we have moved during the past year. In which Food Banks and their Federation have lost purchasing capacity due to the increase in the price of food, having to bear the VAT on them, without being able to pass it on because the food is donated to the people who need it.

However, once again, Food Banks have done an important job in helping the most disadvantaged. Throughout 2022, 3,214 regular volunteers have carried out, selflessly and with great dedication, a commendable work in the 54 Food Banks. My thanks go to them, to civil society, to private enterprise, to Public Administrations and Social Institutions, which have allowed us to deliver 151,684 tons of food, through 6,919 social organizations, to 1,246,106 beneficiaries, of which 22% were children.

With your collaboration, we have managed to minimize environmental impact by recovering 64,992 tons of food in perfect condition that have been distributed to the homes of the most disadvantaged people.

However, we still face many challenges in the fight against hunger and food waste. As partners of the Food Banks, I urge you to continue working together with dedication, empathy and solidarity to help those who need it most. In 2023, we will continue to look for innovative ways to improve our operations and increase our efficiency to reach the most disadvantaged.

Thank you for your efforts; in 2022 solidarity has left its mark in the form of thousands of smiles and well-being.

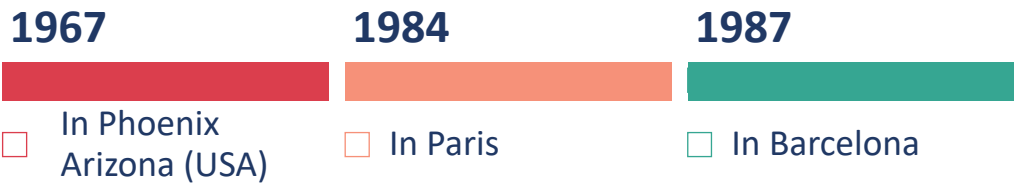

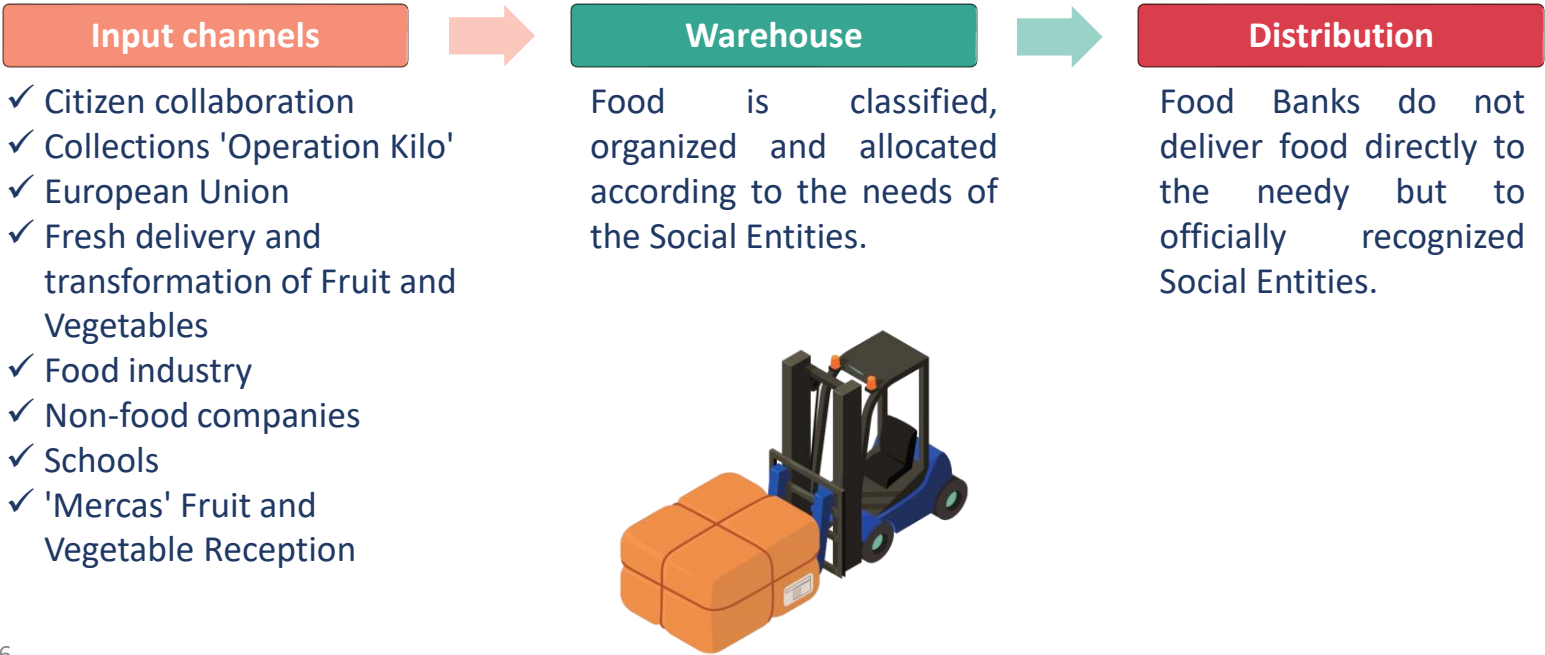
What are Food Banks?

FEBA was founded on September 23, 1986



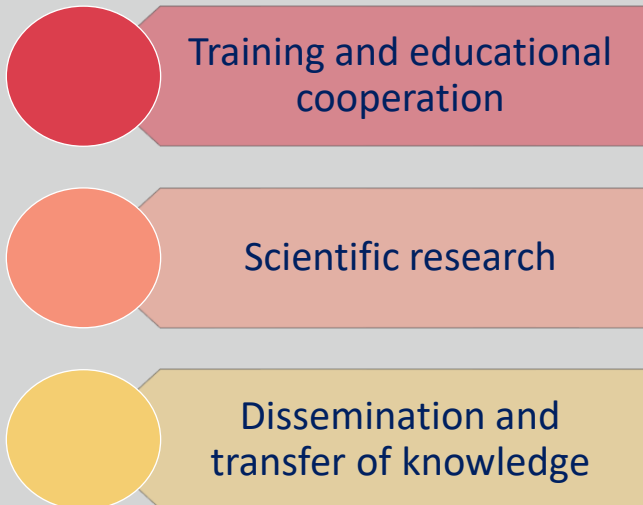
UPM Chair – Food Banks

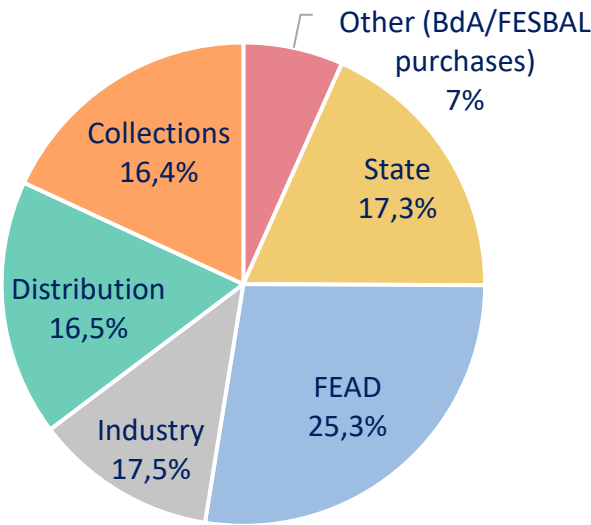

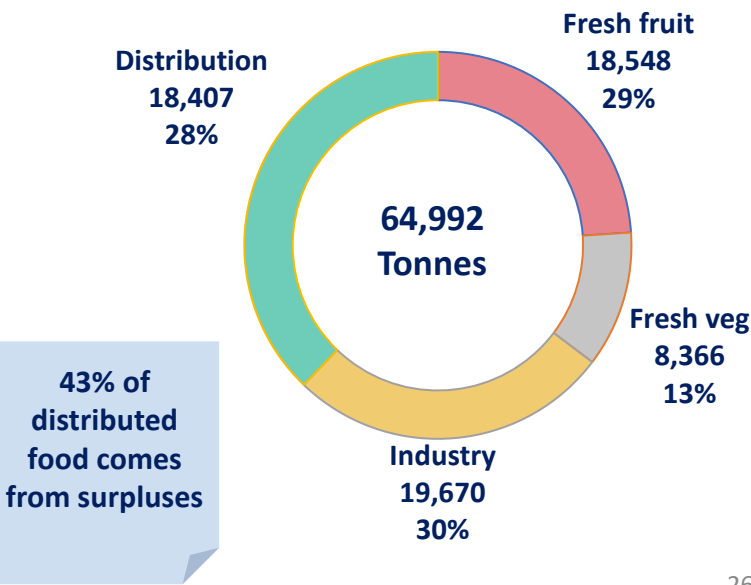
Type of product (Kg/L)
