Letter from the President

I want to express my most sincere gratitude to each of our 3,238 permanent volunteers and our 229 workers for your dedication and effort during the past year to support our mission: covering the food needs of the vulnerable population in Spain.

Also to the more than 90,000 volunteers who collaborated in the two collections last year.

We started 2023 knowing that it was going to be the final year of the FEAD Program, and that it was not going to include basic foods like oil or milk in its food basket. Food prices continued their upward path until closing at an average of 11.8%, two tenths higher than the previous year.

In this complex scenario, Food Banks distributed a total of 138,046 tons of food through 6,493 social entities in 2023, which reached 1,187,976 beneficiaries, of which 21% were children. Thanks again to the solidarity of society, private companies, Public Administrations and Social Institutions, we have managed to distribute 116 kg per beneficiary during the year.

For yet another year, Food Banks have continued to be leaders in the fight against food waste; recovering and distributing a total of 79,077 tons of food in perfect conditions. To continue being a reference in this field, and thanks to a grant from the Ministry of Social Rights and Agenda 2030, we are developing an innovative project, called PLANB, based on a digital platform that will facilitate the donation of surpluses from donors to Food Banks and social entities.

I would like to thank everyone for your generosity and solidarity to continue our commitment to people in situations of food insecurity.

The Spanish Federation of Food Banks (FESBAL) is a non-profit, apolitical and non-denominational entity founded in 1995, which represents, promotes and supports the work of associated Food Banks in their fight against hunger, poverty and food waste, through distribution to the people most in need, while also contributing to improving the environment.

We are governed by principles of equality and transparency and are accredited by the **Lealtad Foundation**.

In 2012 we received the **Prince of Asturias Concordia Award** in recognition of our career as a Social Entity.

FESBAL is an active member of the European Federation of Food Banks (**FEBA**) and its Board of Directors. This Federation brings together 351 Food Banks that fight against hunger and poverty in 30 European countries.

In 2022, they distributed 876,316 tons of food, reaching 12.4 million people in need.






Our Impact in Numbers

The work of the **54 Food Banks** and **FESBAL** is possible thanks to the selfless collaboration of **3,238 volunteers** who help all year round in the management, classification and delivery of food and the **78,552 people** who volunteer in one of the Great Pickups we organize.

Food Banks have distributed **138,046,944** kilos/liters among **6,493 certified charitable entities** that go to their warehouses to stock up on food and deliver it to **1,187,976** beneficiaries.



National food collection campaigns have accounted for 15.3% of the food collected by Food Banks in 2023.

The two solidarity fundraising actions have been in a mixed format, with physical food collection and monetary donations at the checkout line. All the large national distribution chains, local distribution chains and 78,552 volunteers participated in them.


